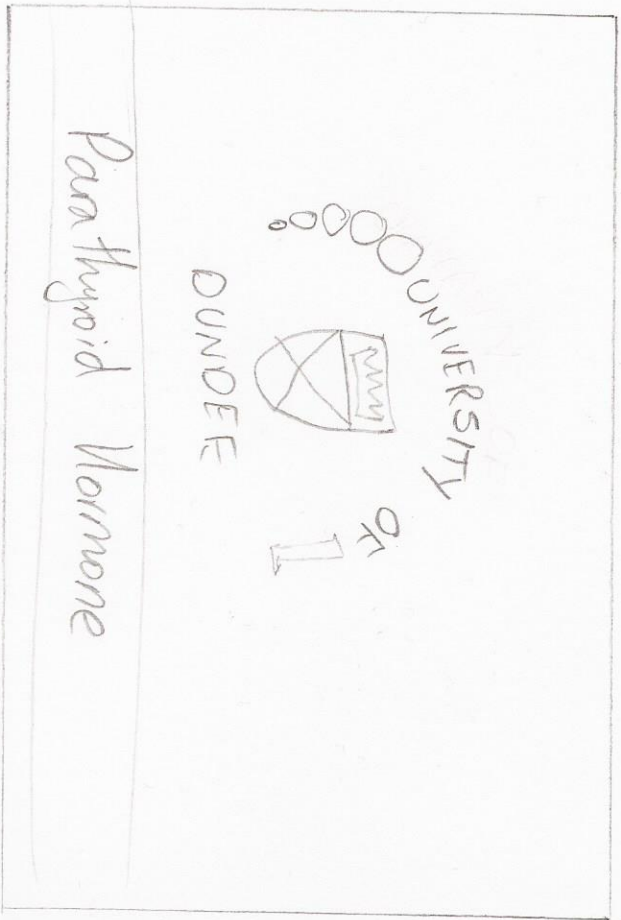

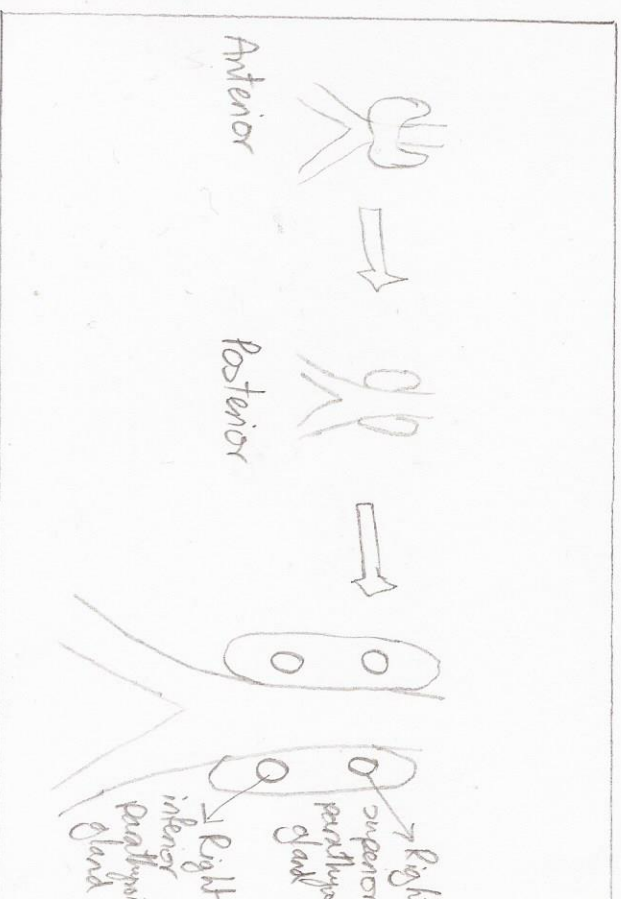


A: Bumper logo video appears then title will show up.

VO: Hello and welcome to my video on the parathyroid hormone. We're going to look at the anatomy of the parathyroid glands, the physiological functions of PTH & what happens if you have too much or too little PTH.

2. Parathyroid Glands



A: Start with anterior view then move through with arrows as VO continues

VO: The parathyroid glands are located on the posterior surface of the thyroid gland's lateral lobes. There are normally 4 parathyroid glands: left & right superior parathyroid glands & left & right inferior parathyroid glands.

T: Anterior, Posterior, Right superior parathyroid gland, Right inferior parathyroid gland
